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Chamomile

When it comes to calming skin effectively, this flowering herb is queen. Its anti-inflammatory properties make it a natural go-to topical for sensitive types, says New York City dermatologist Marina Peredo. But it's a wise winter option for anyone, and is found in many treatments (see our picks, left). "Chamomile is filled with powerful antioxidants, such as polyphenols and phytochemicals," says Peredo. "It provides protection against damaging free radicals and helps diminish the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles." You can find different varieties (Moroccan, Roman, even blue chamomile), but they all offer benefits. For super-reactive skin, doubledip: Peredo suggests applying the ingredient morning and night for maximum pampering and care.
